

# BULKY WASTE

**NIISATO RESIDENTS:** Bulky waste will be collected twice a year. Notification will be given regarding collection days. Dispose of bulky waste at the location designated. Otherwise, make an appointment for pickup (fee charged).

**KUROHONE RESIDENTS:** Dispose of bulky waste on designated days by taking it to the "gomi" station (no fee). In addition, bulky waste can be picked up for a fee by making an appointment.

**ALL OTHER KIRYU RESIDENTS:** Do not take bulky waste to the "gomi" station.

Bulky waste can be disposed of by making an appointment for a collection truck to come to your residence. A fee is charged for this service. Or, you can take bulky waste to the Kiryu City Waste Treatment Center yourself.

(Bulky waste is restricted to household items.)

## Electrical Appliances:

¥410 per item: vacuum cleaners, fans, radios, tape recorders, record players, kotatsu, gas tables, electric heaters, etc.

¥610 per item: microwave ovens, stereos, karaoke sets, speakers, etc.

## Furniture:

¥410 per item: desks, chairs, Japanese chests, standing mirrors, kitchen appliance stands, tatami tables, mattresses, futon, laundry stands, carpets, dish cupboards, etc.

¥610 per item: organs, sinks, chests of drawers, beds, sewing machines, small household furnaces, etc.

## Vehicles:

¥410 per item: bicycles, tricycles, baby carriages

## WASTE NOT COLLECTED BY THE WASTE TREATMENT CENTER

### Do not dispose of any of the following at the waste collection stations.

**Large volumes of waste** from big cleaning projects or moving. Deliver waste directly to the Waste Treatment Center or contract with a private waste treatment company (see the list of approved private waste collection agencies).

**Commercial waste** from businesses, offices, stores and restaurants. Contract with a private waste collection company (see list on reverse side).

**Industrial waste** from burning, sludge, waste plastics, waste oil, scrap rubber, scrap metal, glass shards, ceramic shards, construction scrap materials, greenhouse plastic, containers from pesticides or agricultural fertilizers, etc. Contract an industrial waste treatment company.

**Bulky items** such as motorcycles, automobiles, and industrial machines. Contact a relevant waste treatment agency to handle these items.

**Other items:** Sand, concrete forms, hubcaps, tires, batteries, fire extinguishers, etc. Contact a private industrial waste treatment company to dispose of these items. Personal computers, display monitors should be returned to the manufacturer. See attached explanation. Air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators, freezers and washers / dryers must be recycled by returning them to the appropriate manufacturer. See attached explanation regarding the recycling of household electrical appliances.

**Medical waste** such as hypodermic needles and other medical materials must be disposed of by medical institutions. Inquire at a medical practitioner's office.
