

HOW TO DISPOSE OF PERSONAL COMPUTERS

According to the Promotion of the Efficient Use of Resources Law, household use personal computers and display monitors cannot be disposed of as bulky waste. Owners of such items have the responsibility to return them to the manufacturer and pay for their recycling.

RECYCLABLE COMPUTER TYPES AND RECYCLING FEES

Item	Recycling Fee (tax included)
- desktop personal computer - notebook personal computer - LCD display monitor - LCD display monitor with personal computer in one module	¥3,150 per item
- CRT (Braun tube) display monitor - CRT (Braun tube) display monitor with computer in one module	¥4,200 per item

* Personal computers acquired as of October 1, 2003 which display the PC Recycle Mark do not require payment of the recycling fee at the time of disposal.

Homemade computers or computers for which there are no manufacturers to receive them for recycling can be sent to the “Pasokon 3R Suishin Senta” (Personal Computer 3R Promotion Center) which charges for collecting and recycling them. Recycling fees at the 3R Promotion Center vary from those above.
