

How to Use the Niisatocho “Taxi-on-Demand”

What is the Niisatocho Demand Taxi?

- The service will have two 5-passenger cars available. (The cars will be operated by Numataya Taxi.)
- In order to ride the car, passengers must make a reservation. This public taxi-car will then come to the desired location and deliver passengers to their requested destination. The service will operate anywhere in the Niisatocho district, therefore, those for whom the Niisatocho public bus stops were inconvenient, will now be able to make use of a more convenient service with just one phone call. In addition, the taxi-car will deliver passengers directly to their home.
- This service is intended as a replacement for the Niisatocho Public Bus and will operate only within the confines of Niisatocho, however, the taxi-car will deliver passengers to Sakura Mall and Keiaido Hospital in Midori City. It will not, however, provide transportation between Sakura Mall and Keiaido Hospital.



What are the hours of operation?

The taxi-car operates between the hours of 8:30 am and 6 pm.

How can I use this service?

1. Please make reservations from the day before the desired date up to 30 minutes prior to the desired departure time.
The reservation center (Numataya Taxi) telephone number is 0120-44-2310.
Telephone reservations are accepted between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm.
2. When making a reservation, please include the following information:
 - a. date of requested service (next day or same day)
 - b. time of requested service (between 8:30 am and 6 pm)
 - c. number of passengers
 - d. boarding location
 - e. destination
3. This completes the reservation process.
 - When making a round trip reservation (in the event the time of return is known), passengers may make a return reservation at the same time.
 - Depending on the number of reservations, it may not be possible to reserve the desired date and time.

- In the event there are other reservations for the same destination at the same time, passengers will be asked to ride together, and the taxi may make a detour. Please allow time for this when you make your reservation.
- The demand taxi may arrive a little later than the reserved time.

What is the charge per ride?

Passengers 70 years of age and older are asked to provide proof of age such as a health insurance card, etc. - Passengers may pay in cash as well. - After riding the Niisatocho Demand Taxi with a prepaid ticket, those 70 years of age and over who ride the train to go to areas outside Niisatocho, may request a transfer ticket good for the same day of service only, issued by the Demand Taxi for the Orihime Bus. | |
